

LOK KAWI WILDLIFE PARK

About 1 hour 15 minutes' drive to the southwestern part from the Kota Kinabalu will bring you to the Lok Kawi Wildlife Park, a small wildlife rehabilitation centre. The 280 acres of land hosted nearly 100 species of plants, birds and wild animals. The park has a few interesting sections, namely the aviary, botanical garden, and majority of the parks contains mammals' sections. There is also a children's zoo and amphitheatre inside the park.

Guests able to witness rare animals like endangered pygmy elephants, gibbons, clouded leopard, civet cats, tarsiers and Orang utans. Outside the entrance, there are a few souvenir shops that offer a range of local-products.

8:30am Pickup from your hotel and proceed to Sabah Lok Kawi Wildlife Park.

9:25am Estimated to arrive at the park.

9:30am Proceed to have a walk around and see the animals around. Animal show will also be held at 11.15 a.m. except on Fridays, so don't miss it out.

12:30pm Ready to leave the park.

12:35pm Depart, transfer back to Hotel.

Include: Return Land Transfer (seat-in-coach), Guide, & Entrance fee.

Exclude: Personal Travel Insurance, Personal Expenses & Any items not mentioned.

Things to bring: Cap/hat, Sun Block Lotion, Mineral Water & Camera.
